## Mentoring New Members

The mentoring program is now under way and I look forward to feedback in the New Year, from those who are already involved. We do however, need further assistance from additional experienced members, to help mentor new members.

In my role as New Member contact, I am liaising with “Trainee” and new participants, during their first 3 to 4 race meetings, helping to guide them and act as a reference point. Initially, at their first meeting, the Chief Flag would be involved, getting them to fill out a Trainee Licence and get into overalls for the day, but what happens next?

The next meeting they have a different Chief Flag, so finding continuity can be an issue. Consequently, my position is to help provide that continuity up to and past becoming a member.

After that it is proposed to have a mentoring program in place, so that the new member has a second point of contact, to ask those “silly questions” but also, a single reference point to assist with their future training and development.

The mentoring role is to comprise:

- Making contact with the new member, introduce yourself and making them feel welcome
- Pass on contact details so new member has somebody to ring if they have any queries
- Discuss future events and see if they are interested. If necessary put their name in the “red book” or on data base. Help them to get their “bag” together and give them directions to track.
- On race day, greet them and show them around. Help them with any further queries concerning their Trainee Licence etc
- Introduce them to the Chief Flag, Senior and Team Members for the day.

If you are interesting in helping the committee, please have a chat to one of us.



### General Business
