

If you wake up on race day and are not feeling well it is in your best interest and in the interest of the club for you to call the Chief Flag as early as possible and let him know you are unable to attend. It is far easier to shuffle the team in the morning of the meeting than to have to shuffle people if you are unable to continue trackside.

Your health and wellbeing should always be foremost in your mind if you feel unwell, use the Chief Flag mobile number and call in sick, you will not be looked at any differently for making the smart decision. Please keep this in mind for future meetings as there have been a few cases of people taking ill at the Flag points and having to go to medical. As a club your health and welfare is a major priority help us to look after you.



SPORTING CAR CLUB of SA

- Discussed at recent Committee meeting, a debrief from Master of Mallala Rnd 2 Few incidents occurred and the SCCSA will be writing a letter to SAMROA addressing some concerns. (As of this meeting we have not seen this letter)
- Discussion on the use of lights only at Mallala: some members have concerns that there is a danger that flag skills can be lost if we are forced to use lights only. The lights do have some problems and a proposed software update may address some of them but it should be up to the CF / FP Senior to brief the teams on what is required. What are also required are "repeater lights" on the reverse side of the panels so the officials at the point know that the lights are working. Need to work on procedures who holds the panel? Yellow or Blue person??

COMMUNITY LOTTERY TICKETS

 Currently have 30 books out. (Which is about half) Need to get more out. Janelle has taken 5 books to Darwin to sell. Need to take books to race meetings and sell to drivers and friends. Secretary will do the same for Hill-climbs. (Will continue to monitor sales and if it looks like we won't be able to sell them, return some for re-allocation – in hindsight maybe 75 books was too optimistic)

General Business

- Question was asked about the use of a double sided board at Form Up for Regularity / Superkart events. Also chalk & white boards are unreliable in rainy weather, could magnetic boards and numbers be used as an alternative?
- Darren Mattiske gave a talk on his JDP Schedule for 2015. Not able to use Tailem Bend this year due to the redevelopment so is moving to Adelaide International Raceway. Also looking at bringing his pupils to Mallala to introduce them to a race meeting and maybe get some track time in a regularity event. Contact Darren if you can help out or know someone who may be eligible to join his JDP program.
- Lisette had some concerns at being placed at Form-Up with two trainees – was hard to control / train when called away for red flag situations. Whilst it is recognised that the CF needs to be aware of experience when doing his placements, situations such as red flags are out of their control and the personnel in those positions can only do the best that they can with the experience they have.
- Lisa Totani is completing Year 12 in 2015 and has listed the links for a couple of Investigation Surveys (for Politics and Geography) in our latest Newsletter. All she asks is that you go online and do the surveys. Your assistance and input will be greatly appreciated by Lisa.
