

WHS Report

With the recent Grand Prix and the many upcoming events I thought I would focus on some health issue around hearing and noise induced hearing loss. Motorsport although occurs outside in an open area can still be a very noisy environment.

YOUR HEARING - WHY AND WHEN TO PROTECT IT

YOU DON'T GET "USED TO NOISE"

Noise does not have to be uncomfortably loud to be damaging. You may even think you ears are "used to the noise" but what has probably happened is that hearing loss has already begun. How quickly hearing loss takes place depends on the intensity of the noise, its duration, and how often the exposure occurs.

A RULE OF THUMB

When you feel the need to shout in order to be heard three feet away, the noise levels are probably 85 dBA or more and hearing protectors are recommended.

NOISE DAMAGE INDICATORS

If sounds seem muffled or softer after noise exposure, your hearing is affected by a temporary threshold shift which warns that your ears have been overexposed. If you repeatedly expose your ears without protection, the shift can worsen and become permanent, resulting in untreatable damage to your hearing ability.

Another warning sign, if it's first apparent immediately after a period of high noise exposure, is tinnitus —a ringing, buzzing, or whistling in your head. It's like a "sunburn" of the hair cells of your inner ear, indicating that they have been irritated and over-worked. Tinnitus is especially noticeable in a quiet place, such as when trying to go to sleep at night. If you don't protect your ears from noise, tinnitus can become a permanent, constant annoyance in your life.

REMEMBER: YOU NEED YOUR HEARING!

"You always have this ringing in your ears"

"I miss the birds. I miss all the good sounds"

"My daughter no longer seems to speak clearly"

These comments from people with noise-induced hearing loss show why it is worth the effort to properly wear hearing protectors: your quality of life depends on keeping your good hearing. Once hearing is lost it is gone forever.

Even if you already have some hearing loss, it is still essential to wear hearing protectors from now on to prevent the loss from worsening. It's never too late to start conserving your hearing!






To receive the discount, you just simply present the discount card to the cashier (so it can be swiped electronically from your phone or card, or if need be, processed manually).
