

- Wear clothing that is suitable for your task, thick jumper, thermal underwear, long sleeves, beanie etc
- Wear wet weather clothing, even if its not raining, it will keep the cold wind off you
- Gloves, scarf beanie if possible.
- Try not to sit down too much as this can increase the coldness you feel, try to keep moving.

Track updates:

The Bend are continuing to work through the issues we have raised with them regarding the marshal post, they have begun replacing the metal boxes at the post, we will see at the next meeting how far they have got.

Mallala has seen some improvements lately with the carpet replaced in race control, there has been some work on mowing the grass around the flag post prior to the last event and you will see that fire extinguishers, brooms and oil soaker is know been kept at the flag post.

This maybe a great way to get into modern regularity events and possibly kickstart your racing endeavors or to simply have some fun on weekends.






