T&CC Report

Hello 😊

Whew! We managed to get through the crazy autumn schedule, and we hope everyone has had a chance for a good rest and have enjoyed a few well-deserved weekends away from the track.

We've just come off a pair of events at Mallala, a Superkart & Regularity and a SA Motor Racing Championship round. It was good to see the cold weather didn't deter everyone from helping out. We're also now starting to see a few new faces around events from the club's recent focus on recruitment. I know everyone is making them feel welcome, for they are the future of this club we all care about.

Training continues to be a focus of the T&CC for this year, and we recently ran a webinar on mentoring, both from the standpoint of the Mentor and Mentee. We would like to thank Andrew Leitch for facilitating the training package, and we hope that everyone who attended got something valuable out of it. If anyone would like to provide feedback on this or any of the online training modules run this year, please send it through to tcc@samroa.org.au.

If you are interested in being a mentor to a newer official, or would like to enquire about becoming mentored in a new or current discipline, please get in touch with the T&CC.

For all of those who have not been able to attend the online training sessions, we can also announce that we now have the ability to host recorded training packages from the SAMROA website. Access to the online training will be strictly available to financial members only, and all this year's online training modules should be available soon. Stay tuned for when that becomes available.

For the rest of the year, we are currently planning another online session focusing on communication & report writing, and are still working on arranging an in-person fire training day.

It's no secret that numbers at events have been going down over the last few years, and we'd like to mention some of the measures being implemented by the general committee, event promoters and the T&CC to try and arrest that trend, especially around events at The Bend:

- State Rounds at The Bend typically now provide hot breakfast & dinners for multi-day events, in addition to the excellent lunches procured from the Tailem Bend Bakery.
- The accommodation discounts at the Big4 Caravan Park for officials continue to be available, with 50% rates on most paid rooms and powered sites, and free unpowered camp sites.
- Dedicated officials' dormitories are also in the works at The Bend.
- Most race events now run time-certain, so it is much easier to keep events running to schedule and less chance of finishing later than expected.
- The promoters of the SAMRC are also working on their own reward & recognition scheme to help shore up numbers volunteering for those events. Everyone signing up via My Impact will be eligible.
- Improvements have been made to Flag Post 1 at The Bend, and it is hoped that in time these will be expanded around the circuit.
- The return of the much-valued hot coffee/drink & soup runs!

We would also like to remind everyone, that for all SA Motor Racing Championship rounds, and some other events especially at The Bend, sign-up should only be done via the My Impact links. These regularly are sent out from database emails and are also available from the SAMROA website. If you aren't signing up on My Impact, you may miss out on many of the deals listed above.

We have also been asked to pass along a message to check responses being put into My Impact registrations for each event, as some confusion has been had working out what positions people are requesting. We know this system is still a bit new, so we're always happy to give members a hand in figuring it all out.

We have a few more weeks off again now before the next SAMRC event in late September, I hope to see as many of you out there as we can!

Mentoring....

Some of you may have been asked to be a mentor or there may have been a suggestion that you need to be mentored. Why does this happen...? Don't we just learn on the job and by our mistakes??

Well in some cases we do. But in ensuring we, as race officials, are doing our tasks in the most efficient and professional way, mentoring becomes a key task. Regardless of whether you are new to officiating or have been doing it for many years, there's always tips and tricks we can learn from others. Mentoring allows us to learn from those with experience in a constructive and non-judgemental way.

The Training and Competition Committee has been exploring who is good at being a mentor and who may benefit from being mentored. So, during the course of you being an official, you may get asked, because of your experience, to guide another official in gaining a greater understanding of how and why we do what we do. To assist everyone in understating what mentoring is all about, we have developed a simple and informative training session to be delivered online. It will cover topics such as, developing a mentoring plan, facilitating the mentoring relationship, discuss and explore ideas on problem solving and persuasive techniques, providing feedback in a positive and constructive way by using the "hamburger" technique and much more.

You'll see it come up as an event on the database and you'll need to register your interest to obtain a link to access the event. Don't worry though, if you can't make it, it will be recorded so it can be accessed later.

Please consider your skillset and think about if you could be a mentor or could you benefit from being mentored. Approach a T&CC member to discuss this further and remember, all of us, even those that have been around for a while, can always benefit from observation from others to help make us the best we can be.

WHS Report
