

The program for the remainder of the year is now on the database, so have a look & put your name down straight away.

It has been observed that some officials are perhaps not taking enough food & water trackside, to stay healthy & alert during the day. Cool weather can be a trap, because you do not feel as thirsty, however, your body is still dehydrating which can affect your health & concentration. Please always take more than you feel you need to the track & also ensure that your fellow officials are drinking plenty of fluid as well. If you run out, contact Race Control for more water to be dropped off. This is a better alternative to being stood down for the day.

Senior Officials need to maintain a level of competency periodically, by actively participating in senior rolls. You put a lot of effort into getting your Officials Licence to this level, so don't let it lapse because you have not carried out a particular roll at least every licence renewal period (currently 4 years). If you need to undertake a position to maintain your competency & your licence grade, please contact a T&CC member, especially in say November when the program for the following year is being formulated. Better to maintain licence level than go through the whole process again.

The CAMS Junior Development Program (Tarmac) is open to anyone eligible to hold a CAMS (Confederation of Australian Motor Sport) Junior Competition Licence and the ideal age group is 14 to 17. Previous driving experience is not essential but definitely an advantage, however, we are looking for students who are passionate about motorsport and wish to compete in motorsport events.

Training Activities

Each JDP day has three activities:

- Classroom Theory Training Sessions
- Workshop & Special Presentations
- On Track Driver Tuition Sessions


