

Peter joined SAMROA in 1987 at the ripe old age of nearly 21, he quickly became a devoted member of SAMROA, attending just about every event held at AIR and then Mallala and he did this for over 15 years.

Peter has held various positions on SAMROA's committee's over a period of time, he was part of the General committee for many years as well as the T&CC which he chaired from 2006 to 2009, was the assistant newsletter editor in 95/96 and was also responsible for the development of SAMROA's Training Manual.

He has been awarded SAMROA's most improved official for the 92/93 season and was co-club member of the year in 07/08.


