

If you wake up on race day and are not feeling well it is in your best interest and in the interest of the club for you to call the Chief Flag as early as possible and let him know you are unable to attend. It is far easier to shuffle the team in the morning of the meeting than to have to shuffle people if you are unable to continue trackside.

Your health and wellbeing should always be foremost in your mind if you feel unwell, use the Chief Flag mobile number and call in sick, you will not be looked at any differently for making the smart decision. Please keep this in mind for future meetings as there have been a few cases of people taking ill at the Flag points and having to go to medical. As a club your health and welfare is a major priority help us to look after you.



MOTOR RACING PANEL (MRP) REPORT (Presented by Darren Mattiske)

- Discussion on a full Debris Fence to be erected along the pit wall at 2016 Clipsal 500.
- Regularity category drivers are asking for clarification on the rules for passing in corners
- Introduction of a third Modern Regularity group. Starting at next event 31May15 – group three will consist of Formula Vee and Formula Fords – strictly speed event!!
- 2015 Improved Production Nationals 10 to 12th July, Hidden Valley Raceway, Darwin, NT.
- Rotax have comprehensively upgraded their 125 engine now known as a Rotax 125 Max Evo. 5 versions Micro, Mini, Junior, Senior and DD2. Changes include New Piston, Conrod and Crank, New Carburettor, Ignition System, Electronic Power Valve, Exhaust system (more durable, quieter and lower weight)

- Question on Recruitment of Officials and should SAMROA have a Recruitment Officer. We do have a New Officials position on T&CC and Bronwen did also say that the subject is being discussed at the Committee level) The SAMROA Officials Handbook was also discussed, updates are being planned and will be released in the near future. Also discussion on Tailem Bend and how we should direct our efforts to recruit in the SE area. Peter C. has already had an initial discussion with Sam and Yasser Shahin about us advertising through the OTR chain of petrol stations.

- General discussion on U18s and Child Safe Officers within SAMROA. A question was asked if a "Child Safe" trained person is needed to be placed at each position where there is an official under the age of 18. The answer is no! It is considered well within the guidelines, if on the day, there are one or two officers in attendance who have attended the Child Safety awareness training and the U18 person is able to be placed at a point with a minimum of three personnel. This could cause some concerns at say, a superkart meeting (where numbers at points are lower) but as more members undertake the training the problem will disappear. Apparently, The SAMROA database can display persons with the relevant credentials to aid CFs in placing U18s track-side.

All members just need to be aware that this is a growing requirement and the Association needs to abide by the legislation. If there are any concerns or you just need some clarification, contact the Committees and we'll get the information out to you.
