



## Registering

If you have not previously registered, click on *register here* and the following page will be displayed:

If you have already registered and/or have received your login details, simply login using the credentials provided.

Please remember the password is case sensitive, and if you continue to have problems please contact a committee member.

### Member Registration This system is for current SAMROA members ONLY. This system allows members to manage their own contact details, view committee member details, view placing history, as well as add their name to future race meetings (like the red book). ## **Resending Passwords**

## Using the system

#### Main Menu

The layout of the database is quite consistent. The menu for navigating the system is on the left, and the menu detail being displayed on the right.

Upcoming Events (circled) is used to add your name to the list.



The menu options on the left are:

#### Back

Back will simply take you to the previous page you were looking at. It is preferable to use this back rather than your web browsers back button as your web browser may attempt to enter data in twice, so try to get into the habit of using this back button

#### Main menu

This is in every menu and will simply take you back to the Main Menu screen.

## Logout

This will log you out of the system and display the login page again. Please do this if you decide to access the system from a public place such as an Internet Café or Library. This option is on every screen.

#### **Edit My Details**

This will take you to the screen where you can edit/update your own details as well as view your financial details.

#### My Reports

This will take you to the screen where you can access various reports about your membership.

#### **Committee Information**

This screen will show you all the current committee members and their contact details.

#### **Upcoming Events**

This will take you to the screens where you are able to view where you were placed at prior events, as well as mark yourself as available/unavailable for future events.

#### **Change Password**

As the name implies, use this option to change your password to access the system.

## **Upcoming Events**

This is probably the other main part of the system. This part allows you to view all the race meetings throughout the year and will show you where you worked at a meeting (assuming you did), and if the meeting is in the future, you are able to mark your availability for an event in a similar way as the "red book".

#### Click on View/Edit My Availability



#### Edit/View my Availability

This screen enables you to view/edit your availability for a particular event.

In the above example you can see my name is NOT on the list. To add your name to the gate list, click on "Add my name to the list"

Remember it is good manners and common courtesy to advise the chief flag is you are removing your name from the list.
