

WH&S Report - Cathy Sinton

Hello and welcome to another WHS newsletter article.

I hope everyone is well and survived a busy couple of months of motor sport.

With the arrival of winter comes much cooler and cold days, so when you're planning your next race meeting attendance remember to pack your wet weather gear, it can be an assistance not just to keep you dry but to help keep the wind off you on those windy day's trackside, remember you may be out in the open, both Tailem Bend and Mallala are very open areas and there is very little to stop the wind chilling you to the bones so rung up.

If you are someone who feels the cold or normally works in an office and will feel the cold consider bringing a flask of a hot drink, tea, coffee, hot chocolate or even soup to drink during the day and may help keep you warm.

When trackside you need to ensure you are comfortable in the clothing and shoes you are wearing. This means having good quality shoes, whether they be sneakers or steel cap safety shoes, safety shoes are the better option. There are a lot of various safety shoes on the market, ensure you get ones that are comfortable and a good fit, having good quality socks on with them is also important. You need to ensure the clothing you are wearing is comfortable and adequate for your role, we should all be wearing long sleeve shirts, long pants for both sun safety and our protection when attending an incident. It is important that our clothing protects us from the weather and from injury including cuts and or fire. The club's preference is for hi-viz orange and white clothing, understanding at times these can be hard to get, if anyone knows of or has contacts for our members to get decent priced protective clothing for trackside use, feel free to share it or pass it on to either me or someone on the committee to be included in this newsletter. Don't forget you maybe trackside for the whole day so bring plenty of food, drink and a chair \bigcirc You're there for enjoyment not torture.

Remember if you are unwell at all please don't attend an event, this includes race meetings and general meetings, stay home and take care of yourself.
