

WH&S Report - Cathy Sinton

Hello and welcome to August WHS news.

I hope everyone is well and surviving another round of lock downs and cancellation of many events including motorsport.

Over the weekend I heard the sad news of a motorsport Marshall tragically lost their life trackside at Brans Hatch, this is a reminder to us all that motorsport is dangerous, and we need to be aware of what is happening around us at all times when we are working trackside at events.

Although I'm not aware of the exact circumstances of the incident it acts as a reminder that we need to work together and be alert at all times as incidents can occur at any time. There has been lots of safety improvements of the years at motorsport circuits around the country however these incidents highlight that we need to look after each other.

It's important to remember when we get to our Marshall post we need to inspect it and ensure the post and surroundings are suitable for the task we need to undertake, check the barriers, tyre walls, equipment, access/egress and ensure everything is suitable and in good condition prior to beginning, if something is not suitable, damaged or missing contact race control or chief flag immediately to have the issue rectified. A report should also be completed to ensure any identified hazards are notified to the circuit owner and recorded.

If anyone feels this incident has triggered or brought on any emotional distress or thoughts, Motorsport Australia has the services of a number of counselling services available free of charge for members, there is also the motorsport Chaplin services available to members, please reach out to any of these services at any time or reach out to family, friends and other officials, no one should feel they have no one to chat to, we are all here together.



Although it still can be chilly trackside, we need to ensure we dress appropriately when trackside, be prepared for every season in one day at times.
