



As a chief flag for one of the events it can be very stressful trying to put together placements for an event when numbers are dismal, it's even harder when you are trying to ensure there is sufficient people with experience in positions know for incidents, however no matter how well you try it's a harder exercise when there are insufficient people. I ask if you are free on a weekend when there is an event on can you please consider putting your name down and attending, your help is always appreciated, and remember that's what you joined SAMROA for, to be trackside. A special shout out to all our experienced generation, we need you to help train our newer members, your skills and knowledge is beneficial trackside.

With the warmer weather coming it's time to remind you all of the need to be both sun smart and hydrated during the warmer day's trackside. Check your sunscreen's use by date, remember if it's out of date throw it out and get new one, it's no good if it's too old. Also, with the warmer weather it's a good time to take your wet weather gear out of your bag and both wash and air it out so there is no risk of any mould etc starting to grow as a result of the many wet days trackside lately. Check you have a decent hat, sunglasses, and hydrolyte in your bag.

In some good news it's good to see some improvements have been undertaken at Mallala post 1 recently. There have been some extra dirt mounds placed around the edges of the post to build up to the cement base to remove the risk of a person stepping of the cement base to the ground. Currently the mound is just dirt and at the recent meetings the area became very muddy as result of the wet weather, after discussion with Derek, (Groundsman), he advised they are wanting the area to grow grass to match in with the rest of the grass area, he has agreed to place some carpet on the ground area when we are trackside to reduce the mud area and slipperiness to our marshals working in the area. This has occurred as a result of good communication between SAMROA and Mallala, let's keep up the good work and I encourage you if you have any concerns, please raise them with myself or the committee.

Bunning's were very impressed and pleased with the way the day went from set up to pack up and extended an invitation to come back.












I must thank those who came out on the day to promote SAMROA:
